

GOOGLE EARTH - VIEWING FILES

To view Google Earth files it is necessary to have Google Earth installed on your computer.

Go to <http://earth.google.com/>

Click on Get Google Earth Free version <http://earth.google.com/download-earth.html>

Follow the instructions on screen to download Google Earth to your computer.

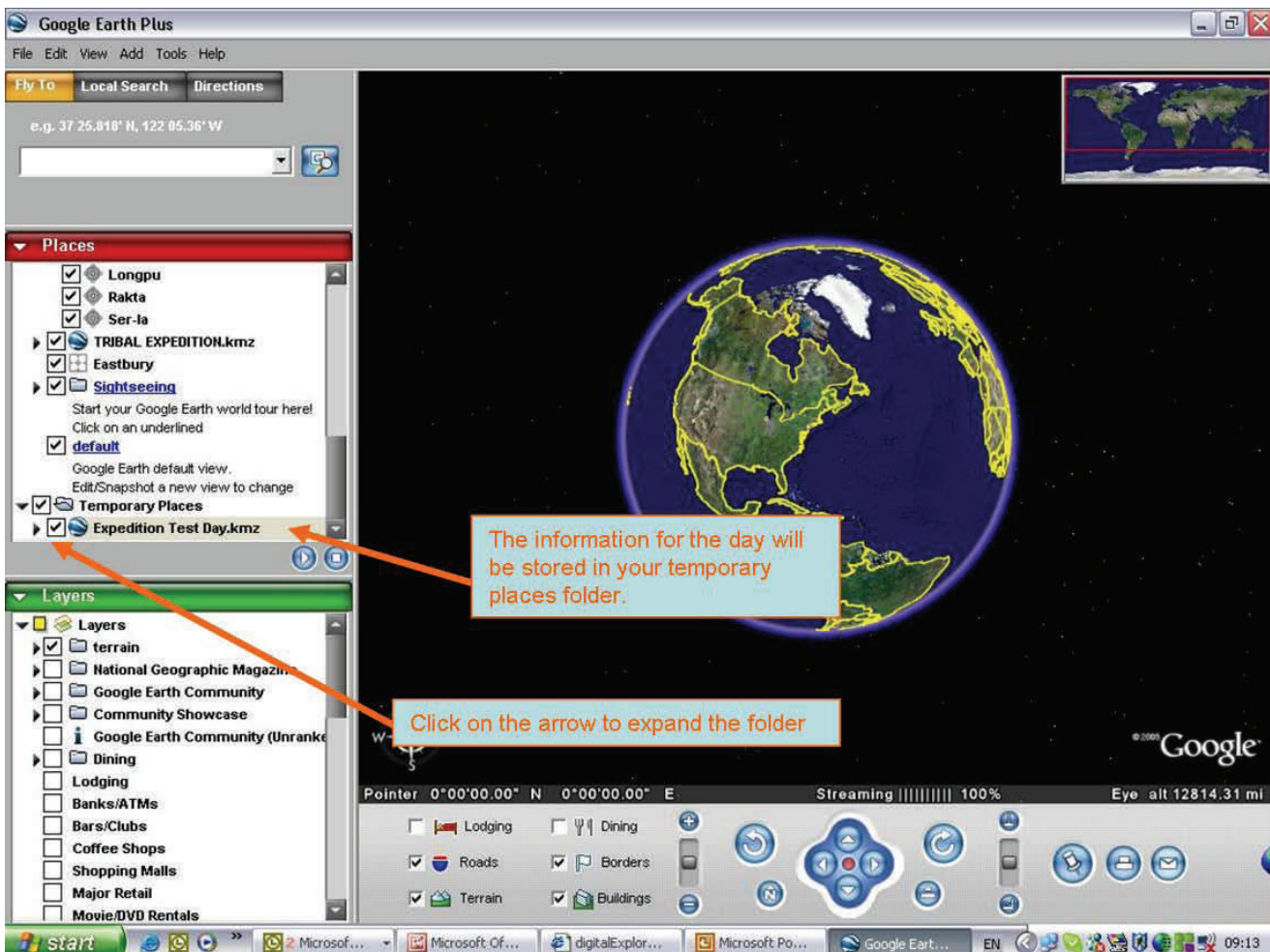
Step 1—opening the .kmz file

Once you have installed Google Earth you can then click on the link in the internet browser.

You will be asked whether you would like to save or open the file:

1. Click 'Open'
2. Double click on the icon
3. Click 'Open'

This will then open the information in the Google Earth Browser. See below for further instructions.

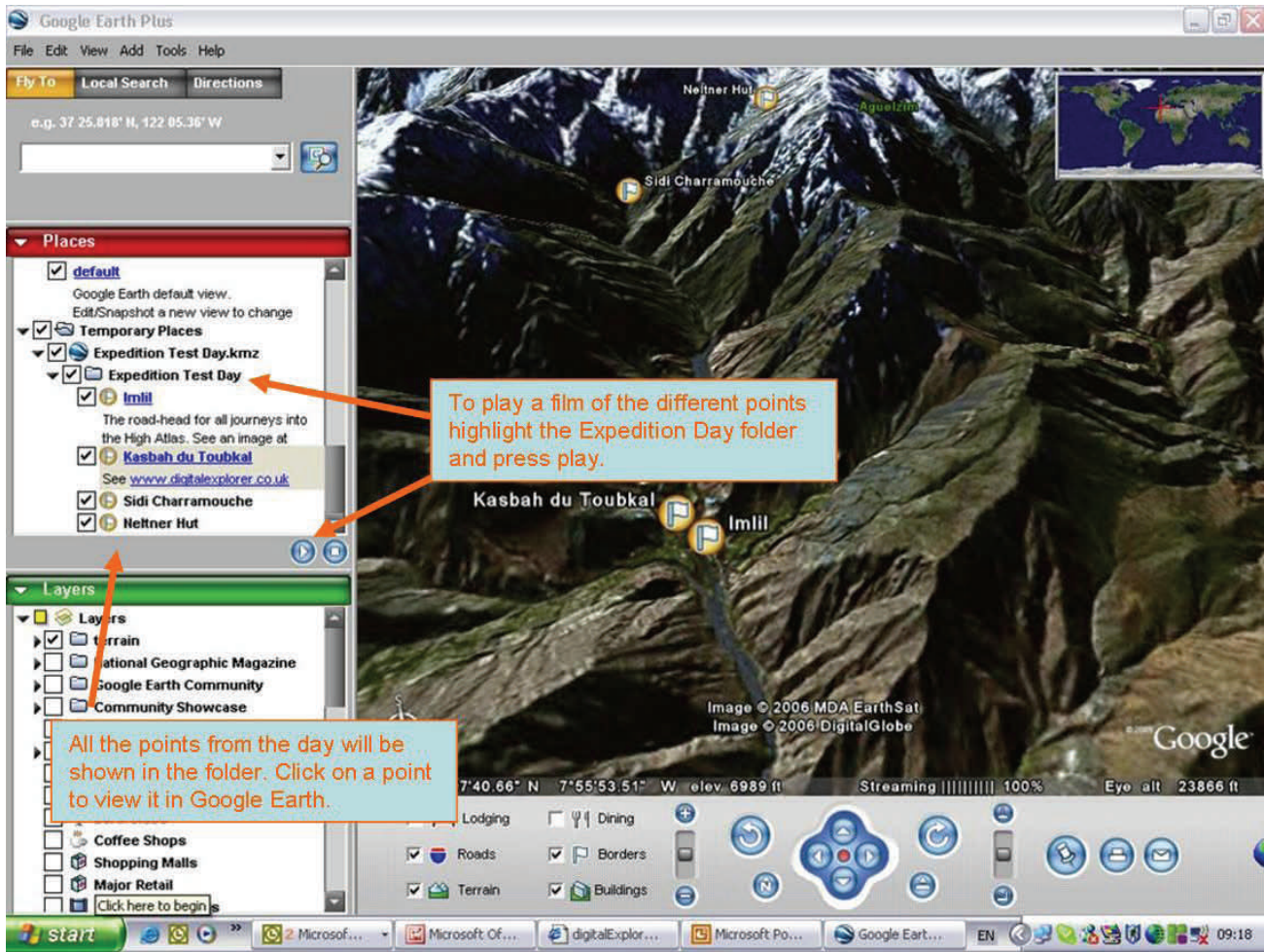


Step 2—viewing the information

The information can either be viewed as single points or as a film.

To view as single points click on an item.

To view as a film, highlight the day folder and press play.



Step 3—saving the information

To save the information:

1. Highlight the placemark or folder you would like to save
2. Click on the file menu
3. Click 'Save as'
4. Select the folder where you would like to save the file
5. Click 'Save'
